1. **CALL TO ORDER** Mayor Bishop called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

2. **WORKSHOP AGENDA ITEMS**

- a. Discussion and possible action on an emergency expenditure for leak injection on the Town Lake Dam.

A motion was made by Alderwoman Almond, with a second by Alderwoman Gilliland to approve the emergency expenditure to fix Town Lake Dam. All in favor, none opposed. Motion carried.

- b. Discussion and possible action regarding how to proceed with the JLK center and arena.

- c. Discussion and possible action regarding the water issues in the City of Llano.
