

ORDINANCE 1580

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING THE HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF LLANO, LLANO COUNTY, TEXAS, AND EXTENDING THE BOUNDARY LIMITS OF SAID CITY SO AS TO INCLUDE SAID HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED PROPERTY WITHIN SAID CITY LIMITS, AND GRANTING TO ALL THE INHABITANTS OF SAID PROPERTY ALL THE RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES OF OTHER CITIZENS AND BINDING SAID INHABITANTS BY ALL OF THE ACTS, ORDINANCES, RESOLUTIONS, AND REGULATIONS OF SAID CITY; AND ADOPTING A SERVICE PLAN OR AGREEMENT.

WHEREAS, (§ Sec. 43.0115 of the Texas Local Government Code and/or Charter) of the City of Llano, Texas, an incorporated city, authorizes the annexation of territory, subject to the laws of this state.

[If applicable] WHEREAS, an offer of a development agreement pursuant to §[43.016] of the Texas Local Government Code has been made and rejected.

WHEREAS, the procedures prescribed by the (Texas Local Government Code and/or Charter) of the City of Llano, Texas, and the laws of this state have been duly followed with respect to the following described territory, to wit:

Tract one being 1.112 acres comprised of Lots 1-6, BLK 32 Barlers addition to the town of Llano and a portion of Chestnut Street that lies adjacent to said lot 1 Block 32 a 30 foot wide right of way


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL (OR COMMISSION) OF THE CITY OF LLANO, TEXAS:

1. That the heretofore described property is hereby annexed to the City of Llano, Llano County, Texas, and that the boundary limits of the City of Llano be and the same are hereby extended to include the above-described territory within the city limits of the City of Llano and the same shall hereafter be included within the territorial limits of said city, and the inhabitants thereof shall hereafter be entitled to all the rights and privileges of other citizens of the city of Llano and they shall be bound by the acts, ordinances, resolutions, and regulations of said city.
2. A service plan or agreement for the area is hereby adopted and attached as exhibit A.


The City Clerk (or Secretary) is hereby directed to file with the County Clerk of Llano, Texas, a certified copy of this ordinance.
