

**RESOLUTION NO. R-2026-09**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LLANO, LLANO COUNTY, TEXAS, ORDERING THE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD JOINTLY WITH ADMINISTERED BY THE LLANO COUNTY ELECTIONS ADMINISTRATOR ON MAY 2, 2026, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING THREE (3) COUNCIL MEMBERS AT LARGE, TO THE LLANO CITY COUNCIL TO HOLD OFFICE FOR A PERIOD OF TWO YEARS; DESIGNATING LOCATIONS OF POLLING PLACES; DESIGNATING FILING DEADLINES; PROVIDING FOR A RUNOFF ELECTION; ORDERING NOTICES OF ELECTION TO BE GIVEN AS PRESCRIBED BY LAW.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LLANO, TEXAS, THAT:**

**SECTION 1:** Election is hereby ordered to be held jointly with the on May 2, 2026, for the purpose of electing three (3) City Council Members, to fill the expiring terms on the Llano City Council;

**SECTION 2:** The Election Day polling place where qualified voters shall cast ballots at such location in the City of Llano, 2026 General Municipal Elections are as follows:

**Llano County Library  
102 E Haynie  
Llano, TX 78643**

Election polls shall be open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on the date of the election.

**SECTION 3:** Early voting for this General Election shall be conducted by the Llano County Elections Administrator. The early voting period of said election is established by law, and the Clerk shall keep the office open for early voting from April 20, 2026, through April 28, 2026 with the exception of San Jacinto Day, Tuesday April 21, 2026, in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Election Code, and as listed below:

**SECTION 4:** Candidates must file for a specific place and adhere to the filing deadlines accordingly. Candidate Packets are available in the City Secretary's Office. The candidate filing periods for the General Election for three council members two-year terms begin at 8:00 a.m. January 14, 2026. and ends at 5:00 p.m. February 13, 2026. Candidates must file in the City Secretary's Office located at 301 W Main St., Llano, TX

**SECTION 5:** If two or more candidates for the office of Council Member tie for the number of votes required to be elected, the tie shall be broken in accordance with the Texas Election Code, including Chapter 2 thereof.

**SECTION 6:** The City Secretary is hereby authorized and directed to publish and/or post, in the time and manner prescribed by law, all notices required to be so published and/or posted in connection with the conduct of this election. The Llano County Election Administrator, in accordance with the contracts, shall designate the election judges for the joint election. The election, including providing the notice of the election, shall be conducted in accordance with the Texas Election Code and other applicable laws, and all qualified residents, and registered voters of the City shall be eligible to vote at the election.

**SECTION 8:** The Mayor and the City Secretary of the City, in consultation with the City Attorney, are hereby authorized and directed to take any and all actions necessary to comply with the provisions of the Texas Election Code and any other state or federal law in carrying out and conducting the election, whether or not expressly authorized herein.


