

ORDINANCE NO. 1521

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LLANO, TEXAS, AMENDING ORDINANCE 1311 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 102, ARTICLE VI, ELECTRIC RATES, SECTIONS 102- 235(b), 102-37, 102-39, AND 102-40; PROVIDING FOR A REPEALER CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; PROVIDING FOR PROPER NOTICE AND MEETING.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Texas Local Government Code § 51.001, the City Council of the City of Llano, Texas ("City Council") has the authority to adopt, publish, amend or repeal an ordinance that is for the good government, peace or order of the City of Llano ("City"); and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to change the residential electric rate from 2 tiers to 1 tier for the City Distribution Charge; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is unnecessary and proper for the good government, peace, and order of the City of Llano to amend the Code of Ordinances to remove the formula calculating the kWh consumed by residential customers each month for purposes of determining the City Distribution Charge;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LLANO, TEXAS, THAT:


Chapter 102; Utilities, Article VI, Electric Rates, Section 102-235(b) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Llano, Texas is amended to read as follows:

(b) Residential Electric Rate

- i. **APPLICABLE:** To single family residential customers for all domestic usage where all energy is taken through a single meter
- ii. The monthly rate shall be the sum of the following charges which are hereby authorized by the master fee schedule that is adopted each year,
 - a. Customer Service Charge
 - b. City Distribution Charge
 - c. Power Cost Adjustment
