**HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN UPDATE**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LLANO, TEXAS, TO  
APPROVE THE TEXAS COLORADO RIVER FLOODPLAIN COALITION  
HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN UPDATE**

**WHEREAS,** natural hazards in the Colorado River Basin historically have caused significant disasters with losses of life and property and natural resources damage; and

**WHEREAS,** certain areas of the City of Llano are subject to periodic flooding and other natural and man-caused hazards with the potential to cause damages to people properties within the area; and

**WHEREAS,** the City of Llano desires to prepare and mitigate for such circumstances; and

**WHEREAS,** the City of Llano is a participating member of the Texas Colorado River Floodplain Coalition (TCRFC); and

**WHEREAS,** the Federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) require communities to adopt a hazard mitigation action plan to be eligible for the full range of pre-disaster and post-disaster federal assistance for mitigation purposes; and

**WHEREAS,** FEMA requires that communities update hazard mitigation action plans every five years; and

**WHEREAS,** the City of Llano has assessed the community's potential risks and hazards and is committed to planning for a sustainable community and reducing the long-term consequences of natural and man-caused hazards; and

**WHEREAS,** the TCRFC's Hazard Mitigation Plan Update outlines a mitigation vision, goals and objectives; assesses risk from a range of hazards; and identifies risk reduction strategies and actions for hazards that threaten the communities in the region.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LLANO THAT:**

1. The 2016 Llano County, Texas Hazard Mitigation Plan, dated (May 2016) approved and adopted by the Commissioners Court of Llano County and resolves to execute the actions in the plan.  
And;

2. The City of Llano will also pursue available opportunities for implementation of the proposals designated therein, and will seek to implement the actions contained in the mitigation strategies; and
3. The City of Llano vests with the Mayor the responsibility, authority, and means to inform all parties of this action; assure that the Hazard Mitigation Plan Update will be reviewed at least annually; and that any needed adjustments will be presented to the City Council for consideration; and
4. The City of Llano agrees to take such other action as may be reasonably necessary to carry out the objectives of the Plan Update and report on progress as required by FEMA and the Texas Division of Emergency Management (TDEM).
