

ORDINANCE NO. 1179

An Ordinance of the City of Llano, Texas amending Ordinance 1177 Llano Municipal Code Chapter 102 Utilities; Article II. Utilities Services and Accounts; Section No. 102-37. Billings, 102-39 Delinquent Bills; and 102-40. Disconnections; Customer Notification. and providing an effective date.

WHEREAS, these regulations are designed to insure fair, consistent, courteous, and safe provision of utilities to all customers of the City of Llano. All previous rules and policies which are in conflict with these regulations are superseded.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Llano, Texas, that:Llano Municipal Code Chapter 102 Utilities; Article II. Utilities Services and Accounts;

SECTION 1.

Section No. 102-37 Billings be amended as follows:

Utility bills are mailed to customers on the last working day of each month. Payment of such bills is due on the ~~10th~~ (15th) day of the following month, or the next succeeding working day if the ~~10th~~ (15th) day of the month is on a weekend.

Section No. 102-39 Delinquent Bills be amended as follows:

A utility bill becomes delinquent on the ~~15th~~ (16th) day of the month and a penalty of ten percent shall be applied to the customer's account per the Utility Service Application and Agreement. Delinquent customers shall be notified three days prior to termination of service.

Section 102-40 Disconnections; customer notification be amended as follows:


If delinquent bills are not paid within ~~15~~ (10) days following the ~~10th~~ (15th) day of the month, utility service shall be discontinued on the 26th day of the month. Service disconnections shall be made only between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

SECTION 2. CONFLICT WITH OTHER ORDINANCES, SEVERABILITY.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances, or resolutions in conflict herewith are expressly repealed. The invalidity of any section or provision of this ordinance shall not validate other sections or provisions thereof.
