

ORDINANCE NO. 1197

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LLANO, TEXAS, LEVYING AD VALOREM TAXES FOR USE AND SUPPORT OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT FOR THE CITY OF LLANO, TEXAS, AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO PROMOTE THE GENERAL HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE FOR THE 2011-2012 FISCAL YEAR, PROVIDING FOR APPORTIONING EACH LEVY FOR SPECIFIC PURPOSES; AND PROVIDING WHEN TAXES SHALL BECOME DUE AND WHEN SAME SHALL BECOME DELINQUENT IF NOT PAID.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby levied and there shall be collected for the use and support of the municipal government, and to provide an Interest and Sinking Fund for the retirement of existing indebtedness of the City of Llano, Texas a tax of \$.39 on each \$100.00 of valuation of all property, real, personal and mixed, within the corporate limits of the City of Llano and which is subject to such taxation.

The tax rate will raise taxes for maintenance and operations. Said tax shall be levied and apportioned to the specific purposes here set forth:

- a) For the maintenance and support of the general government, \$.39 on each \$100.00 valuation of property which is a 0.6% increase; and
- b) For the Interest and Sinking Fund, \$0.00 on each \$100.00 of valuation of property.

SECTION 2. That taxes levied under this Ordinance shall be due October 1, 2011, and if not paid on or before January 31, 2012, shall immediately become delinquent.


SECTION 3. All such taxes shall become a lien upon the property against which assessed.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the passage of this Ordinance by the City Council.
