# EXECUTIVE ORDER

## OCTOBER 04, 2011

**WHEREAS**, by Ordinance No. 1035 issued the 20th day of March 2006 and amended by Ordinance 1138 issued the 6th day of July 2009; the Mayor of the City of Llano, Texas has declared that certain emergency measures be taken; and

**WHEREAS**, The 7-day moving average daily discharge of the Llano River at Llano gauge is equal to or less than 40 cubic feet per second (cfs) triggering Stage 2- Moderate Water Shortage Conditions.

### **NOW THEREFORE, Stage 2 Response – Moderate Water Shortage Conditions**

Goal: Limit the daily pumpage at the water treatment plant to 1.0 million gallons per day.

Water Use Restrictions: Under threat of penalty for violation, the following water use restrictions shall apply to all persons:


1. Water customers shall limit the irrigation of landscaped areas with automatic irrigation systems or hose-end sprinklers to twice per week on the designated water day during the hours of 12 Midnight to 10 AM and 7 PM to 12 Midnight.

#### **Designated Watering Days**


Odd Numbered Addresses	Wednesday and/or Saturday
Even Numbered Addresses	Thursday and/or Sunday
Commercial, Multi-family	Tuesday and/or Friday
