### EXECUTIVE ORDER JUNE 13, 2011

**WHEREAS**, by Ordinance No. 1035 issued the 20th day of March 2006 and amended by Ordinance 1138 issued the 6th day of July 2009; the Mayor of the City of Llano, Texas has declared that certain emergency measures be taken; and

**WHEREAS**, The 7-day moving average daily discharge of the Llano River at Llano gauge is equal to or less than 21 cubic feet per second (cfs) triggering Stage 3- Severe Water Shortage Conditions.

#### **NOW THEREFORE, Stage 3 Response – Severe Water Shortage Conditions**

Water Use Restrictions: Under threat of penalty for violation, the following water use restrictions shall apply to all persons:

Goal: Limit the daily pumpage at the water treatment plant to 0.8 million gallons per day.


Water Use Restrictions: All requirements of Stage 2 shall remain in effect during Stage 3 except:

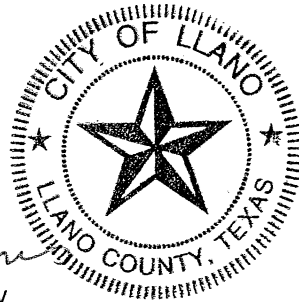
1. Irrigation of landscaped areas shall be limited to designated watering days between the hours of 6:00 AM and 10:00 AM and between 8:00 PM and 12:00 Midnight, and shall be by means of a hand-held hose, a faucet-filled bucket or drip irrigation system only. The use of hose-end sprinklers or permanently installed automatic sprinkler systems are prohibited at all times.
2. The watering of golf course fairways is prohibited.
3. The use of water for construction purposes from designated fire hydrants under special permit is to be discontinued.
4. Use of water to wash any motor vehicle, motorbike, boat, trailer, airplane or other vehicle not occurring on the premises of a commercial car wash and commercial service stations and not in the immediate interest of public health, safety, and welfare is prohibited. Further such vehicle washing at commercial car washes and commercial service stations shall occur only between the hours of 6:00 AM and 10:00 AM and between 8:00 PM and 12:00 Midnight.

5. The filling, refilling, or adding of water to swimming pools, wading pools, and Jacuzzi-type pools is prohibited.
6. The operation of any ornamental fountain or pond for aesthetic or scenic purposes is prohibited except where necessary to support aquatic life or where such fountains or ponds are equipped with a recirculation system.
7. No application for new, additional, expanded, or increased-in-size water service connections, meters, service lines, pipeline extensions, mains, or water service facilities of any kind shall be approved, and time limits for approval of such applications are hereby suspended for such time as this drought response stage or a higher-numbered stage shall be in effect.
